Job Description

Lakeshore Technical College seeks a part-time instructor who has a passion for teaching and learning in the Carpentry Apprenticeship program. The successful candidate will be one who is willing to use innovative teaching techniques and technologies to create flexible learning environments, is committed to assessment and improvement of student learning, and the development of independent, lifelong learners.

This position is part-time meeting 2 days a month (currently Fridays) at our Cleveland campus. Under the supervision of the Dean of Apprenticeship and in collaboration with other faculty, staff, and the program advisory committee, the individual will conduct program and curriculum development, and will teach and facilitate student learning in the core occupational courses of the building trades.

- Responsible for coordinating the instruction process, associated curriculum review and development, and student advising within the area of instruction.
- Must be willing to commit to all required course contact hours, for each class assignment as scheduled.
- Responsible for maintaining curriculum rigor in alignment with state requirements.
- Required to coordinate the instructional process, to include but not limited to: course preparation, student attendance records, student assessment, grading, and must be accessible to students outside of scheduled classroom time (to include electronic communications as well as in-person meetings).

Required Qualifications*

- Completion of Journey-Level Carpentry apprenticeship and a minimum of two years (4,000 hours) of recent related occupational experience **OR** Bachelor's Degree with two years of verifiable related occupational experience **OR** seven years (14,000 hours) of verifiable related occupational experience.

- Adult teaching experience preferred.
- Experience with computer assisted instruction and software.
- Working knowledge of PC software in a windows environment.
- Possess excellent classroom delivery skills, which encourage success and participation on the part of the students.
